# CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT Admission Guidelines



## CONCURRENT ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be admitted as a concurrently enrolled student you must meet one of the *performance requirement* options listed below **and** be able to satisfy all 15 *curricular and graduation requirements* no later than the last semester of your senior year.

### *Performance Requirements*

**Seniors:** Your first semester of enrollment can be the summer before your senior year.

**Option 1:** Minimum of a 20 ACT or 940 SAT

**or**

**Option 2:** 3.0 minimum GPA *and* class rank in the top 50%

**Juniors:** Your first semester of enrollment can be the summer before your junior year.

**Option 1:** Minimum of a 23 ACT or 1060 SAT

**or**

**Option 2:** 3.5 minimum GPA

### **Home Study or Unaccredited High School:**

Concurrent students who are receiving instruction at home or from an unaccredited high school must be 17 years old and meet the above requirements for high school seniors or be 16 years old and meet the above requirements for high school juniors.

### *Curricular Requirements* (15 Units)

**4 units *English***

(Grammar, Composition, Literature)

**3 units *Math***

(Algebra I or higher)

**3 units *History & Citizenship Skills***

(one unit of American History, plus two units from Economics, Geography, Government, History or Non-Western Culture)

**3 units *Lab Science***

(Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Physical Science excluding General Science)

**2 units *Other***

(select from any of the above and/or Computer Science and/or Foreign Language)



**Course Placement:** Concurrent students must obtain a 19 ACT subject score in English, mathematics, and/or science reasoning to enroll in coursework in the respective subject area. Students must score at least a 19 in reading to enroll in any other collegiate course outside the subjects of English, mathematics, and science.

**Course Load:** Concurrently enrolled students are limited in the number of college credit hours they are allowed to enroll in per semester. A high school student may enroll in a combined number of high school and college courses per semester not to exceed semester credit hours. For the purposes of calculating course load, one-half high school unit shall be equivalent to three semester credit hours of college work. *Concurrent students may enroll in a maximum of 9 semester hours during any summer term.*

Each semester’s maximum course load can be determined according to the following formula.

**EXAMPLE:**

You are enrolled in 5 high school classes for the semester:  $5 \times 3 = 15$ ;  $19 - 15 = 4$ .  
 Your maximum college course load is 4 semester hours.

**“Continuing” Concurrent Students:**

High school students concurrently enrolled in college courses may continue concurrent enrollment in subsequent semesters if they achieve a college cumulative GPA of 2.0 or above on a 4.0 scale.

If you are currently enrolled as a concurrent student at SWOSU and wish to continue your concurrent enrollment for the next semester you must submit a new Application for Concurrent Enrollment. It is necessary to verify your new high school semester schedule and receive permission from parents/guardians for you to enroll. You are *not* required to submit a new Application for Admission, application fee, transcript or test scores.

**“Summer” Enrollment:**

If you are applying for an initial enrollment in a summer term you are required to submit the documents listed below. The Application for Concurrent Enrollment is required, with the exception of the high school schedule.
