*Beginning in 2017-2018, the EPP received data in bar diagram format. See below.

Analysis of data:

Report indicates 13 traditionally trained/ prepared teachers completed this survey for academic year 2017-2018, with 3 survey completers being alternatively certified, 2 emergency certified, and 1 through the para-professional route.

Item #3 “The Learner and Learning - Please rate the extent to which you agree with each statement below. My preparation program/route to certification prepared me to:” responses show a range of 15-16 are within the range of “Agree” to “Strongly Agree” with 10-11 respondents choosing “Strongly Agree” in each area. This indicates a high level of confidence by these first-year teachers. This indicates an area of strength within the preparation program regardless of path to certification. This correlates strongly to item #7 in which 17 respondents felt a strong ability to positively impact student learning.

A clear area of concern is that one respondent indicated that he or she “strongly disagreed” with all survey items concerning the learner and learning, understanding content, assessment, and concepts of inquiry. This seeming complete lack of confidence is concerning, especially if the same first year teacher responded in negative on every item. Another area of concern created from this analysis is that there is no way to disaggregate data based upon path to certification.

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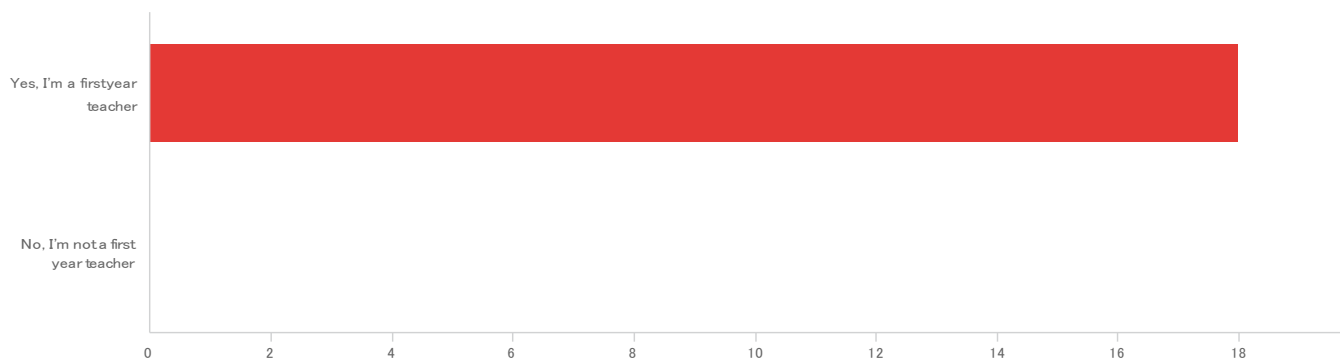

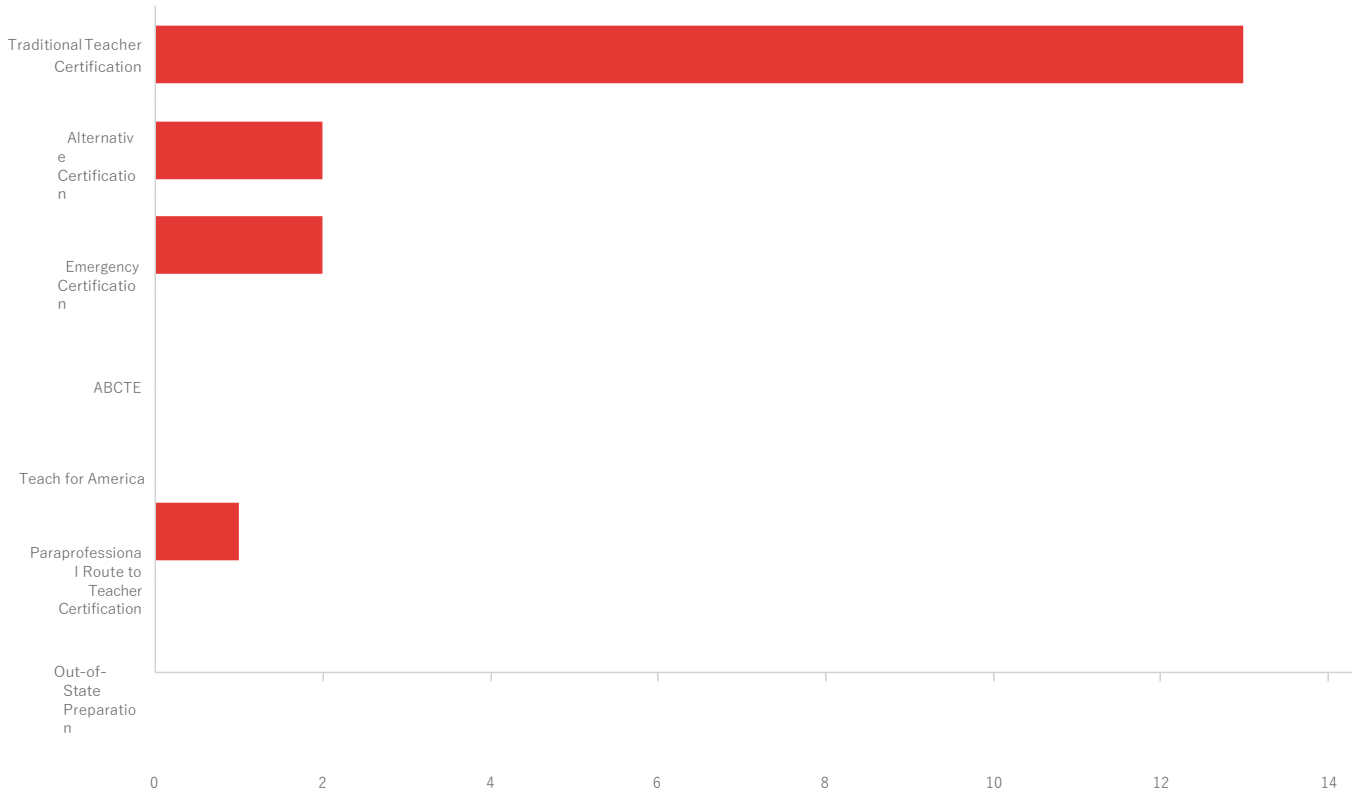

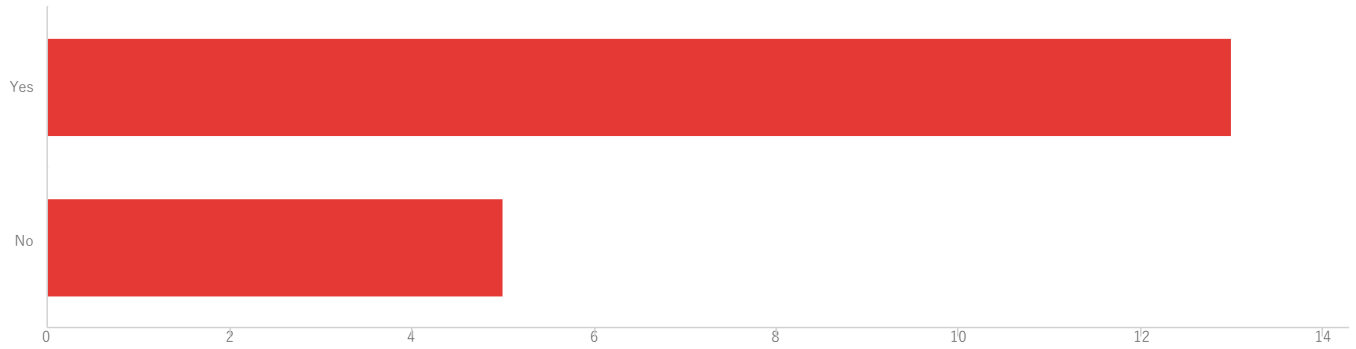

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11. Were you assigned a mentor from your school district this school year?



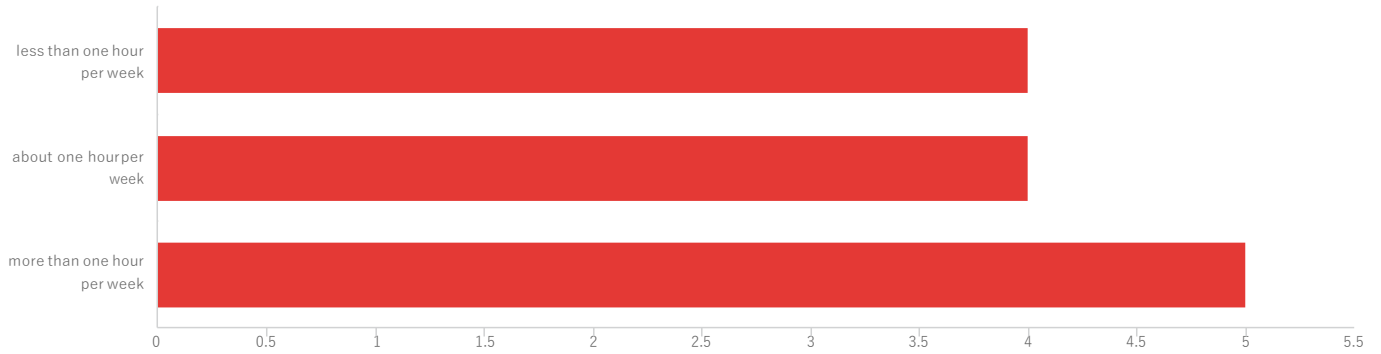

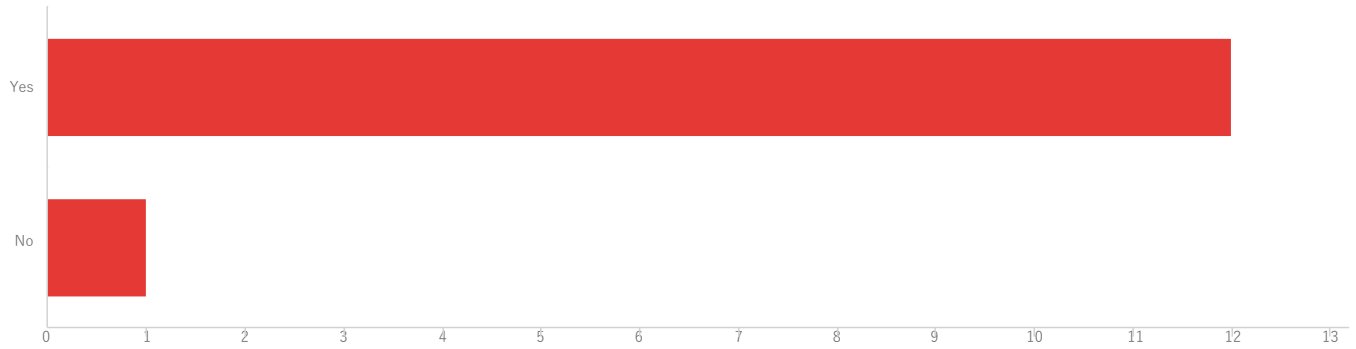

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11b. Is your mentor in your same teaching area?



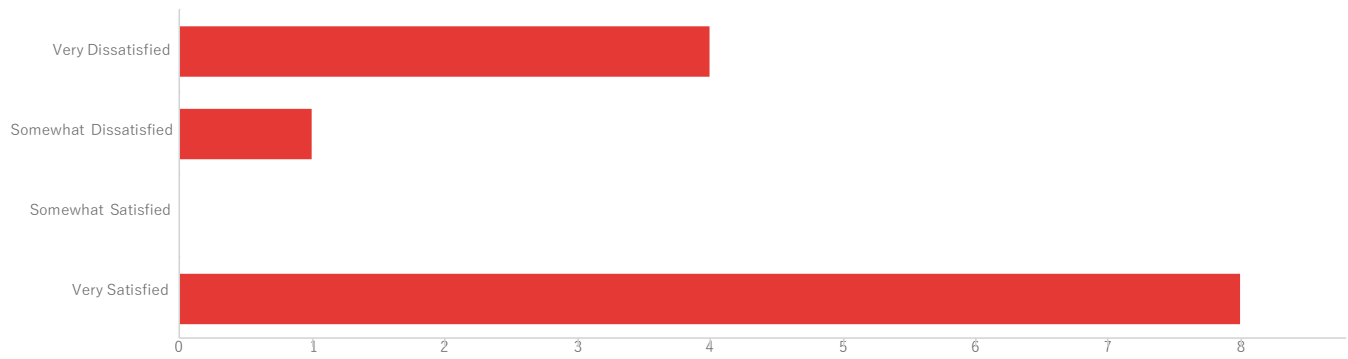

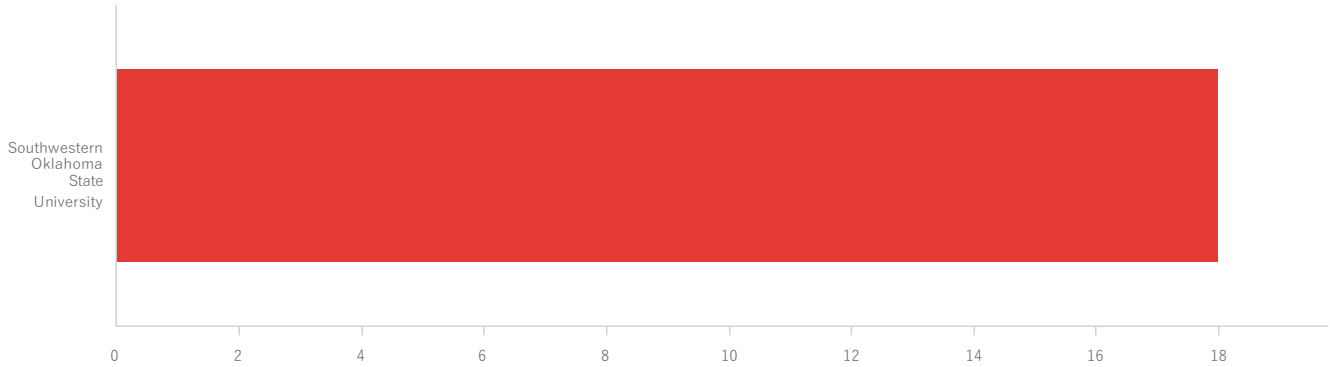

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12. From which of the following institutions did you receive recommendation for teacher certification? If you hold an alternative or emergency certificate please select Oklahoma State Department of Education.

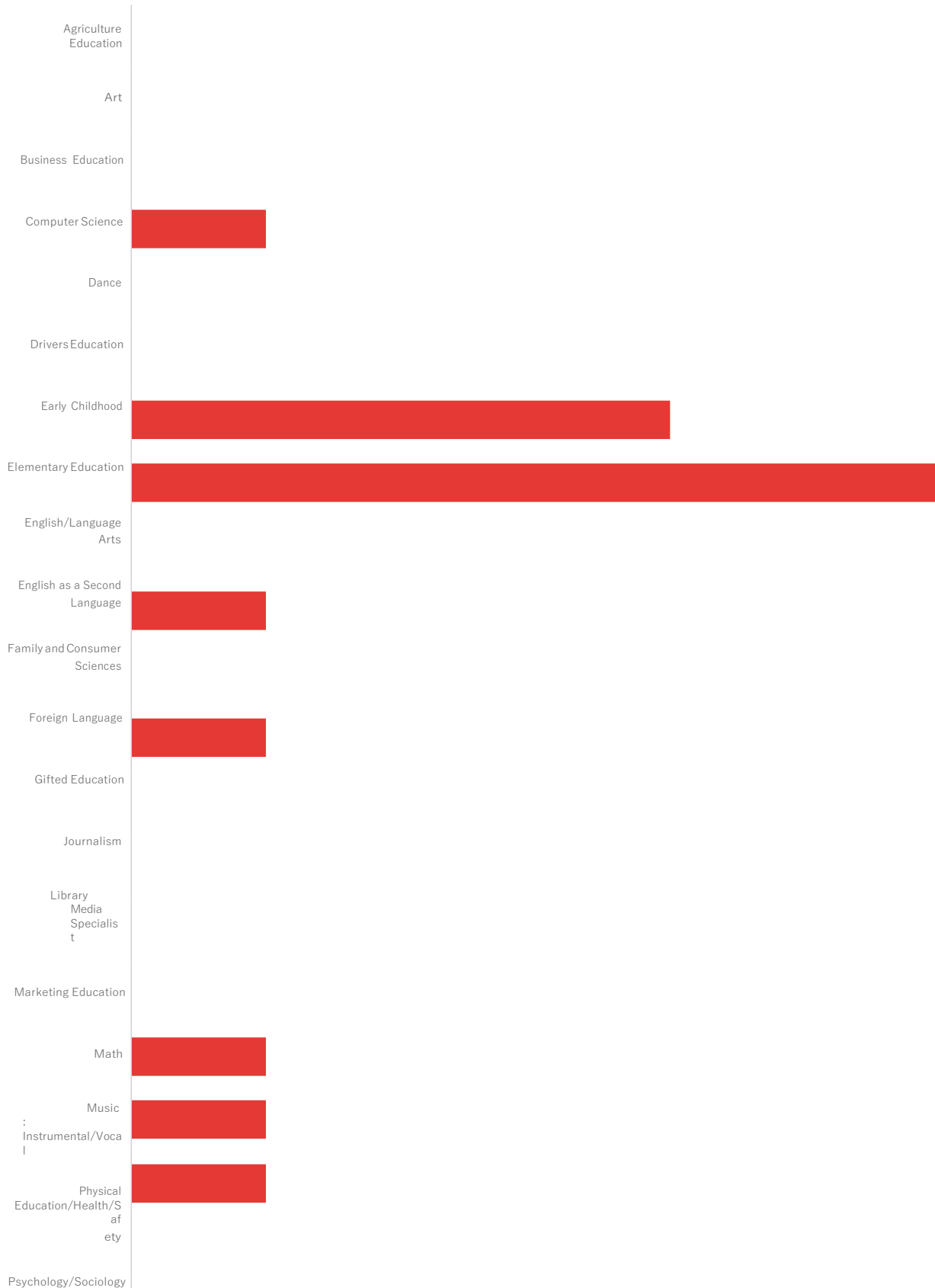

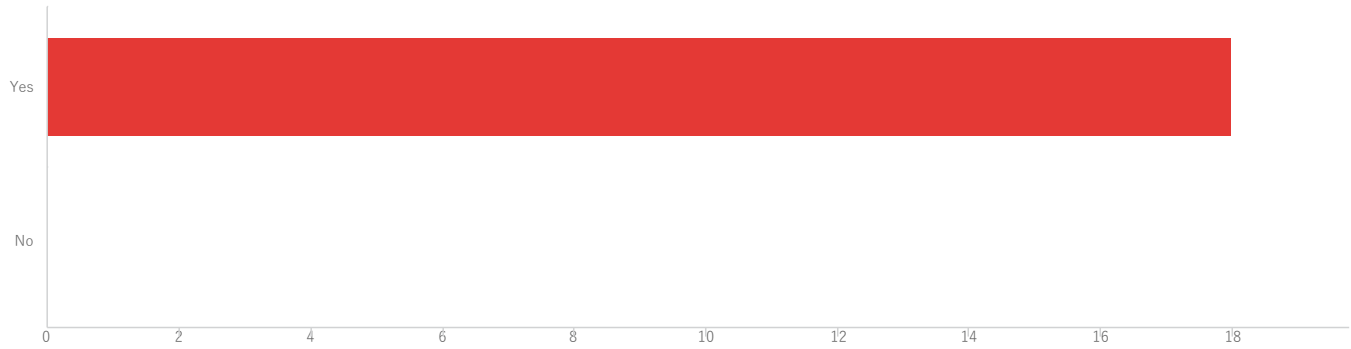

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17. Do you teach at a Title I school?



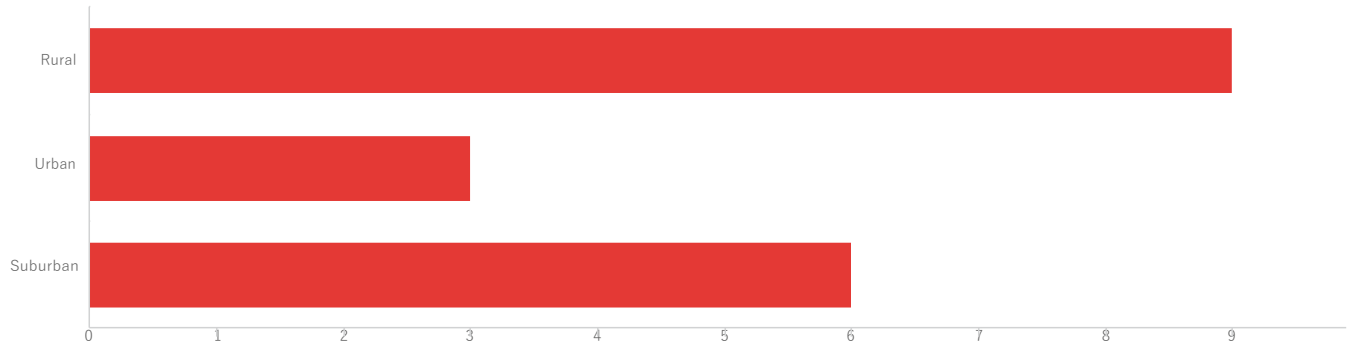

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18. Which of the following describes your school district?



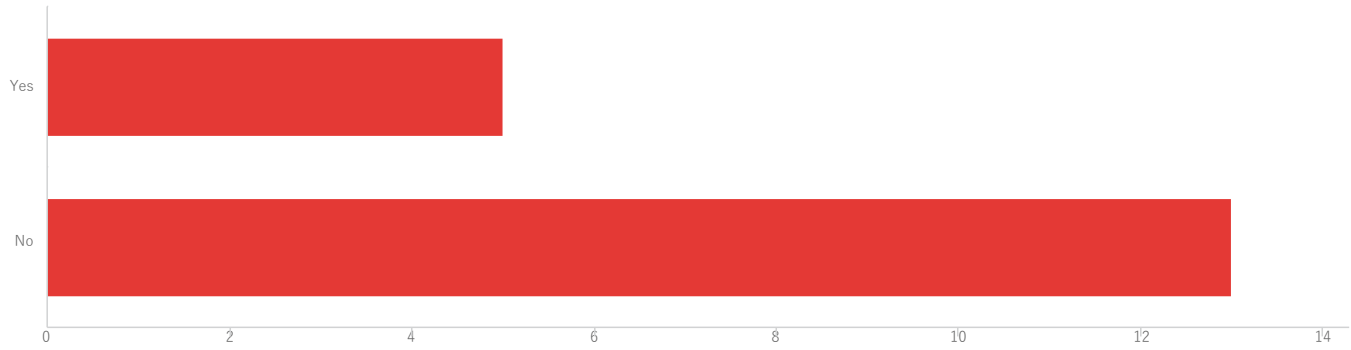
